一般資料及團體參觀

- 1. 團體如屬下列性質及達到要求的參觀人數,即可申請團體參觀服務:
 - (i) 註冊學校(必須為幼稚園、小學、中學、專上學院及大學)、註冊慈善或非牟利團體,參觀人數達20人或以上*;
 - (ii) 註冊學校、註冊慈善或非牟利團體,其服務對象為殘疾人士或長者,參觀人數達10人或以上*。
 - *參觀人數亦包括職員及同行照料者。
- 2. 申請團體必須已根據《社團條例》或《公司條例》註冊立案,或已根據法例成立,或已註冊為認可慈善機構或公共性質的信託團體。在申請團體的章程或組織章程大綱及章程細則,或有關條例或信託契約中,必須明文規定:若團體解散,將其財產剩餘贈予或移交其他相似的團體,或捐作慈善用途,其成員不得分享利潤或資產。
- 3. 註冊慈善團體及非牟利機構於遞交申請時,請附上有關之證明文件副本(如稅務局依據稅務條例第八十八條發出之信件、香港政府憲報所列之註冊慈善團體名單或社會福利署所發出之信件證明該團體為政府資助的團體),以證明其慈善性質或非牟利性質。證書副本必須由機構負責人正式簽署,連同團體蓋印,以示直確。
- 4. 開放時間:

星期六、日及公眾假期:上午 10 時至晚上 7 時

聖誕節前夕及農曆新年前夕: 上午 10 時至下午 5 時

- 5. 惡劣天氣的博物館開放安排
 - (i) 八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號:博物館將會關閉。如熱帶氣旋警告信號取消或改為3號或更低信號時,距離休館時間尚 有3小時或以上,而情況又許可的話,博物館會在2小時內重新開放。如相距休館時間不足3小時,博物館不會開放。
 - (ii) 黑色暴雨警告信號:若博物館經已開放,則開放時間維持不變。若該警告信號在博物館開放前經已生效,博物館將不會開放,直至該警告信號除下。倘若該警告信號除下時距離博物館閉館時間不足兩小時,當日將不會開放。
 - (iii) 「極端情況」*:博物館將會關閉。如「極端情況」取消時,相距休館時間尚有3小時或以上,而情況又許可的話,博物館會在2小時內重新開放。如相距休館時間不足3小時,博物館不會開放。
 - * 遇有超強颱風引致公共交通服務嚴重受阻、廣泛地區水浸、嚴重山泥傾瀉或大規模停電情況,政府會發出「極端情況」公布。
- 2. 参觀團體的旅遊巴士可於博物館公眾停車場上落客,不設停泊。復康巴士可於博物館職員入口(近沙田診所)的有蓋停車場上落客,不設停泊。
- 3. 請勿在博物館範圍內使用擴音器。若遇有緊急事故,活動負責人可請博物館職員提供協助。

- 2) 八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號;或黑色暴雨警告信號已經生效(中學、大專及相類團體適用)
- 3) 教育局宣佈停課(幼稚園、小學、中學及特殊學校適用)

導賞如期舉行:天文台於**導賞開始前3小時或之前除下**

- 1) 三號熱帶氣旋警告信號或紅/黑色暴雨警告信號 (幼稚園、小學、特殊學校、兒童中心、老人中心及相類團體適用);
- 2) 八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號或黑色暴雨警告信號(中學、大專及相類團體適用)

申請手續

- 1. 團體可在參觀日期**三個月至二星期前**預約團體參觀及導賞服務,例如參觀日期為11月,則可於該年8月首個工作天起遞交申請表格。**如申請之參觀日期距遞交申請表格的時間少於兩星期,其申請將不獲接納。**申請將根據先到先得的原則作出安排,唯申請接受與否,博物館保留最終批核權。請選擇兩個擬申請安排導賞的日期及展覽,並列出先後次序,以便博物館作出適當安排。學校/團體如未能提供申請表所需資料,有關申請將不予受理。請將填妥表格經網上遞交,或寄交沙田文林路 1 號香港文化博物館(信封面請註明「香港文化博物館團體參觀」),或圖文傳真 2180 8111 至博物館,以便本館跟進你的申請。
- 2. 提供個人資料純屬自願性質。然而若資料不足,本館職員可能無法處理有關申請。根據個人資料(私隱)條例(香港法例第486章)第十八、二十二條及附表一載列的第六原則,申請人所提供的個人資料,將用以處理其申請。申請人如欲查閱及/或更正本申請表內的個人資料,可致電 2180 8210與行政主任(文化博物館)聯絡。
- 3. 確定申請

博物館會於**參觀日期前兩星期回覆**有關導賞服務申請結果。如申請被接納,博物館會以傳真方式通知有關團體以確定參觀日期及安排。如於參觀日前一星期仍未接獲本館回覆,請與博物館聯絡(電話: 2180 8219 [只申請團體參觀]/2180 8180 [申請團體參觀及導賞服務])。

Hong Kong Heritage Museum Notes on Application for Group Visit and Guided Tour Services

General Information and Group Visit

- 1. The following organisations are eligible to apply for group visit:
 - (i) Registered schools (must be kindergartens, primary schools, secondary schools, post-secondary institutes or universities), and registered charitable or non-profit-making organisations with a visiting group of 20 or more*;
 - (ii) Registered schools, and charitable or non-profit making organisations serving people with disabilities or the elderly <u>with a visiting group of 10 or more*</u>.
 - *The total number of participants also includes staff and accompanying carers.
- 2. The applicant should be registered under the Societies Ordinance or incorporated under the Companies Ordinance or formed by statute or registered on the list of approved charitable institutions or trusts of public character. Its Constitution or Memorandum and Articles of Association or Ordinance Trust Deed should specifically provide that members do not take any share of the profits nor any share of the assets upon dissolution.
- 3. For registered charitable organisation or registered non-profit-making organisation, applicant should produce copies of supporting documents (i.e. Letter issued by the Inland Revenue Department under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance; List of Approved Charitable Institutions and Trusts of a Public Character published on the Government Gazette; or Letter issued by the Social Welfare Department) to identify the charitable nature or non-profit-making nature of the organisation. The copies should be certified true by an authorized officer together with the organisation chop.
- 4. Opening Hours:

Monday, Wednesday to Friday: 10am to 6pm

Saturdays, Sundays & Public Holidays: 10am to 7pm Christmas Eve and Chinese New Year's Eve: 10am to 5pm

Closing Days: Tuesdays (except public holidays) and the first two days of the Chinese New Year

- 5. Inclement Weather Arrangements
 - (i) Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above: The Museum will close. Museums will resume service within 2 hours if the signal is cancelled or lowered to Signal No.3 or below 3 hours or more before the normal closing time as conditions allow. The museums will remain closed if the signal is lowered less than 3 hours before the normal closing time.
 - (ii) Black Rainstorm Signal: If the signal is issued during normal opening hours, the Museum will remain open. If the signal is issued before the Museum opens, the Museum will be closed until the signal is cancelled. If the signal is cancelled less than 2 hours before normal closing hours, the Museum will remain closed that day.
 - (iii) "Extreme Conditions"*: The museum will close. Museums will resume service within 2 hours if "extreme conditions" is cancelled 3 hours or more before the normal closing time as conditions allow. Museums will remain closed if "extreme conditions" is cancelled less than 3 hours before the normal closing time.
 - * In the case of serious disruption of public transport services, extensive flooding, major landslides or large-scale power outage caused by a super typhoon, the Government will make an announcement of "extreme conditions".
- 6. Coaches may drop off/pick up visitors at the public carpark. Rehabus may drop off/pick up disabled visitors at the covered carpark of Museum's staff entrance (near the Sha Tin Clinic). No parking space is provided.
- 7. No loudspeaker is allowed in the Museum. In case of emergency, please approach the Museum staff for assistance.

Group Guided Tour Services

- 1. The number of participants for each tour is limited to 20 persons.
- 2. <u>Unless otherwise stated, a tour will generally take around one (1) hour.</u> No half-hour tour will be provided.
- 3. Special Arrangements Under Inclement Weather Conditions

Guided tour will be cancelled: When the following signal is issued by the Hong Kong Observatory and is still in force 3 hours before the tour is scheduled to begin:

- 1) Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above; or Red / Black Rainstorm Signal (For kindergartens / primary schools / special schools / child centres / centres for the elderly / similar organisations)
- 2) Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above; or Black Rainstorm Signal (For secondary schools / tertiary institutions / similar organisations)
- 3) Education Bureau has announced class suspension. (For kindergartens, primary, secondary and special schools)

Guided tour will be conducted as scheduled: When the following signal is lowered by the Hong Kong Observatory 3 hours before the tour is scheduled to commence:

- 1) Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3; or Red / Black Rainstorm Signal (For kindergartens / primary schools / special schools / child centres / centres for the elderly / similar organisations)
- 2) Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above; or Black Rainstorm Signal (For secondary schools / tertiary institutions / similar organisations)

If school / organisation has other arrangements under inclement weather conditions, please state clearly in the "Remark" column on the application form.

How to Apply

- 1. Applications for group visit and guided tour services can be made <u>up to three (3) months in advance and must be made at least two (2) weeks before the proposed date of visit.</u> For example, if you wish to visit in November, you can make application from the first working day of August in that year. <u>Application made less than two (2) weeks before the proposed date of visit will not be considered.</u> Tours will be arranged on a first-come-first-served basis and are subject to the Museum's final approval. To facilitate arrangements, a visiting group should select two (2) choices of date for their proposed visit and two (2) choices of exhibition to be visited in order of preference. Application will not be considered if applicant fail to provide all information as requested on the application form. Please return the completed form either through on-line submission, by post to Hong Kong Heritage Museum, 1 Man Lam Road, Shatin, N.T. (please mark 'Hong Kong Heritage Museum Group Visit' on the envelope), or by fax to 2180 8111 for the Museum to process your application.
- 2. While the provision of personal data is voluntary, the Museum staff may not be able to process the application due to insufficient information provided. Personal data given by the applicants in this form shall be used for processing the application in accordance with Section 18, 22 and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap.486 HK Laws). Request for access and/or correction of personal data stated in this form should be made to EO(Heritage Museum) at 2180 8210.
- 3. How to confirm your booking
 The Museum will notify schools or organisations the result of application within two (2) weeks before the proposed date of visit.
 If the application is accepted, the Museum will confirm the visit and the arrangements with the group concerned by fax. If you have not received a reply from the Museum one (1) week before the proposed date of visit, please contact the Museum (Tel. 2180 8219 [applied for group visit only] / 2180 8180 [applied for group visit and guided tour services]).
- 4. How to reschedule/cancel your booking Please notify the Museum immediately if you need to make any alterations regarding your visit or to cancel it altogether (Tel. 2180 8219 [applied for group visit only] / 2180 8180 [applied for group visit and guided tour services]).
